PENSACOLA, FL – Effective immediately, in response to bacteriological sampling, the Florida Department of Health in Escambia County (FDOH-EC) is rescinding the health alert for the following beaches in Escambia County, Florida:

Bayou Chico at Lakewood Park

Bayou Grande, Navy Point - North of Sunset Avenue Bridge

Bayou Texar at Bayview Park

The Florida Department of Health in Escambia County feels that the water quality in this area has improved considerably due to the reduction in bacteria levels.
