ALL FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH IN ESCAMBIA COUNTY CLINICS AND SERVICES ARE SUSPENDED ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 28, AND WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 29, 2014.

PENSACOLA, FL – In anticipation of hazardous weather conditions, all locations of the Florida Department Health in Escambia County (DOH-Escambia) will close at 5:00 p.m. CT today and will remain closed until 8:00 a.m. CT on Thursday, January 30, 2014.

All DOH-Escambia clinics and other services will be suspended, including:

- WIC clinic and voucher pick-up services,
- Vital statistics services,
- Environmental health services,
- Dental clinics operated by Escambia Community Clinics and Pro Med, and
- Family health, family planning, immunizations, sexually transmitted disease (STD), tuberculosis (TB), pediatric specialty, and ADHD clinics.

Clients with appointments scheduled for Tuesday and Wednesday, can call 850-595-6500 on Thursday, January 30, 2014, to reschedule their appointment.
