**Pensacola, Fla.** – Effective immediately, in response to bacteriological sampling, the Florida Department of Health in Escambia County (FDOH-Escambia) is rescinding the health advisory for the following locations in Escambia County, Florida due to an adequate reduction in bacteria levels:

- **Quietwater Beach Pier, Pensacola Beach – North of Pensacola Beach Boardwalk**
- **Bayou Texar at Bayview Park**
- **Bayou Grande at Navy Point, North of Sunset Bridge**

A health advisory remains in effect for the following location:

- **Bayou Chico at Lakewood Park**
