How: Appointment needed. Call 850-595-6500 option 6 to schedule an

appointment. Bring a valid form of identification. Rapid testing with results

available within 30 minutes. Questions can be directed to FDOH-Escambia's COVID-19 phone line at 850-595-6500 option 6.

FDOH-Escambia has suspended specimen collection for COVID-19 offered through coordination with Statlab. Closure of the drive-thru testing site is due to a decline in demand for COVID-19 tests. COVID-19 testing sites continue to be available at several locations in Escambia County, including the rapid testing schedule outlined above.
