**Pensacola, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Health in Escambia County (FDOH-Escambia) will suspend specimen collection for COVID-19, effective Friday, April 1, 2022. Testing offered at 1295 West Fairfield Drive in Pensacola is being suspended due to a decline in demand for COVID-19 tests.

Individuals should continue to watch for COVID-19 symptoms. If you develop symptoms of COVID-19, keep your distance from others, be evaluated by your health care provider, and get tested. You can find testing locations [here](#).
