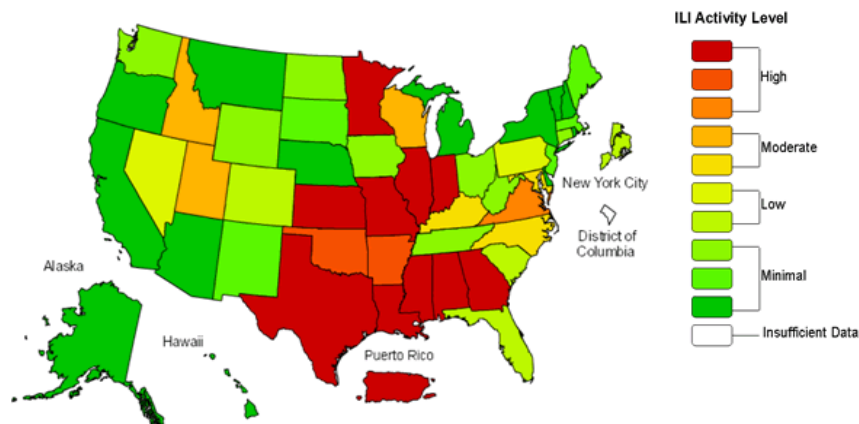

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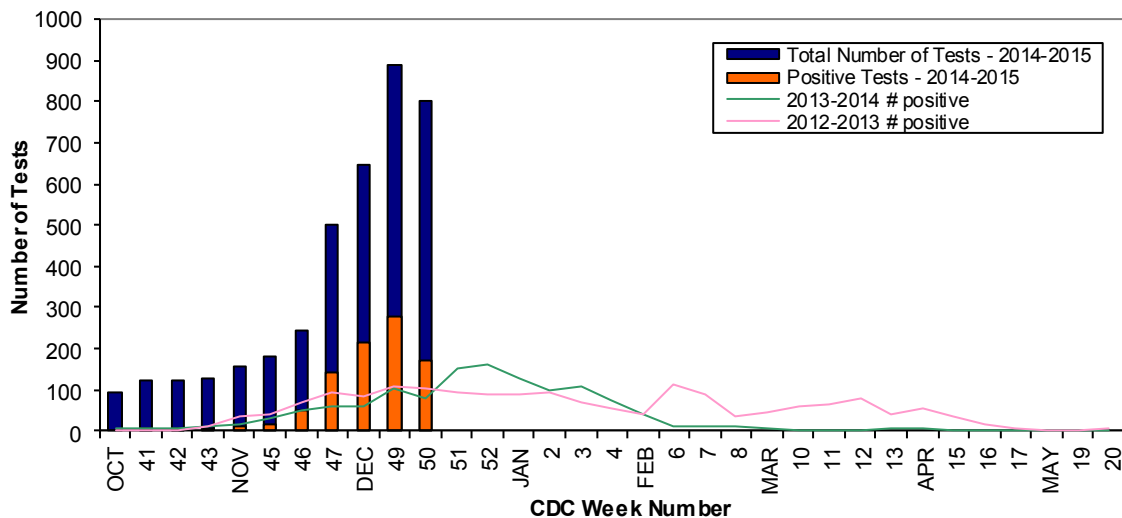


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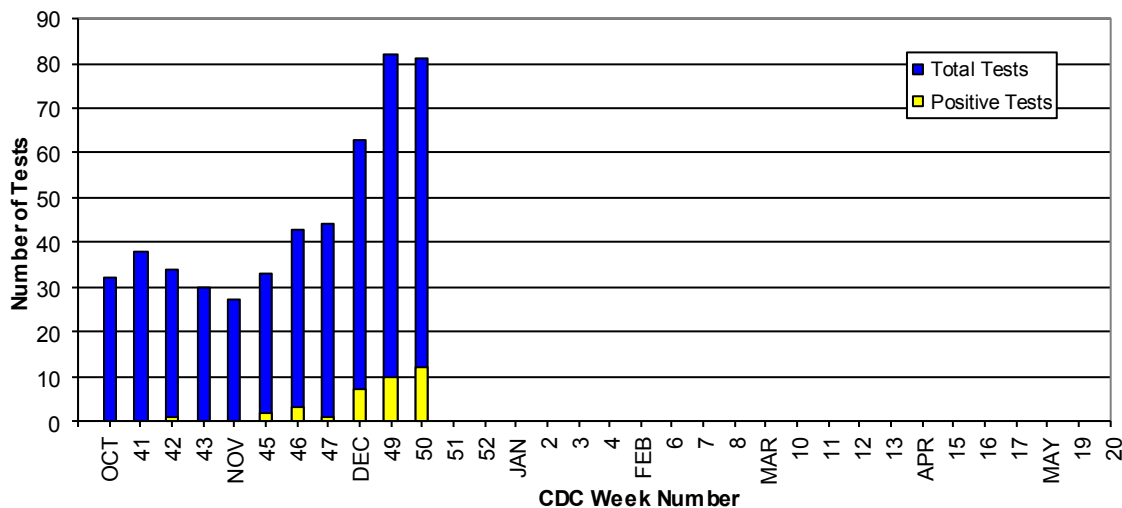
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Influenza Activity in Escambia County - Week 50

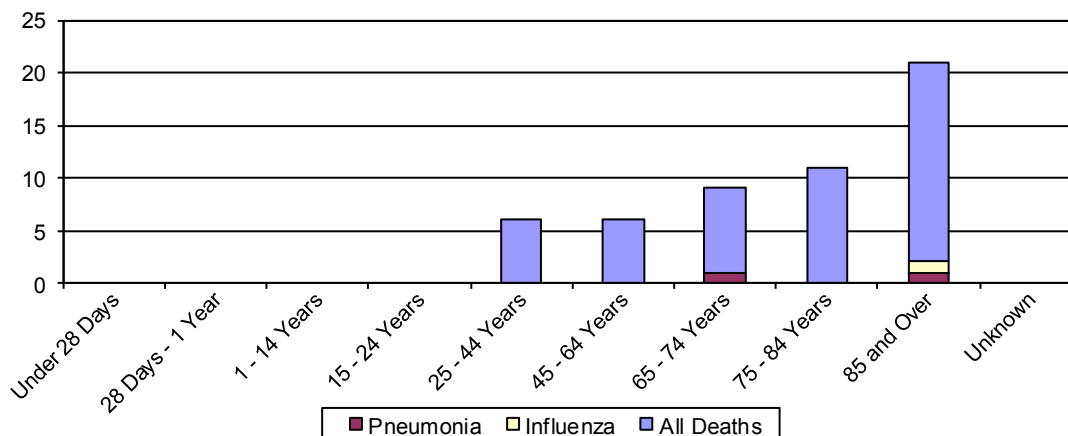
Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Activity in Escambia County - Week 50

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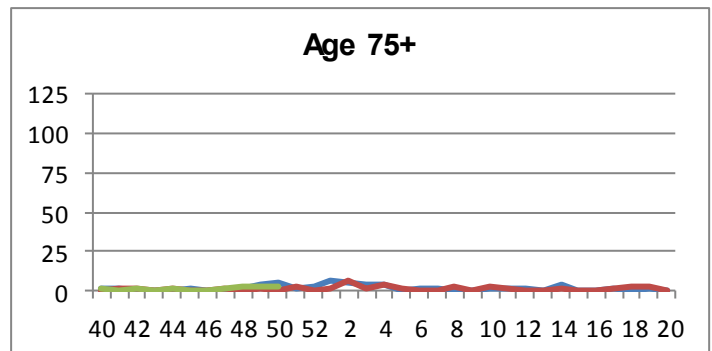
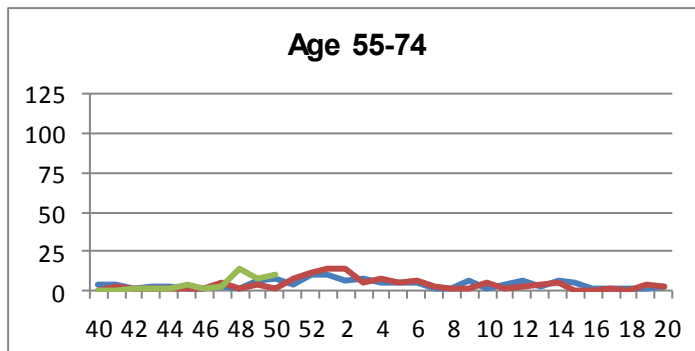
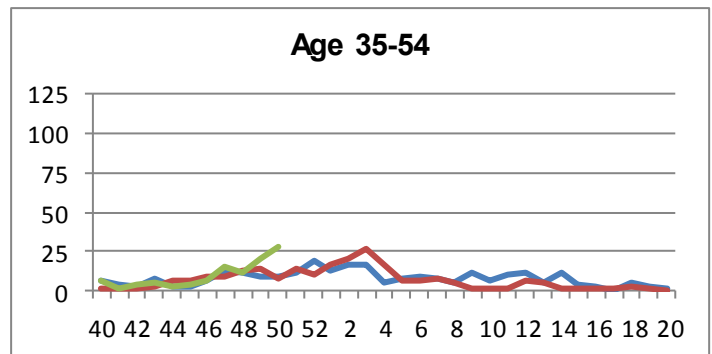
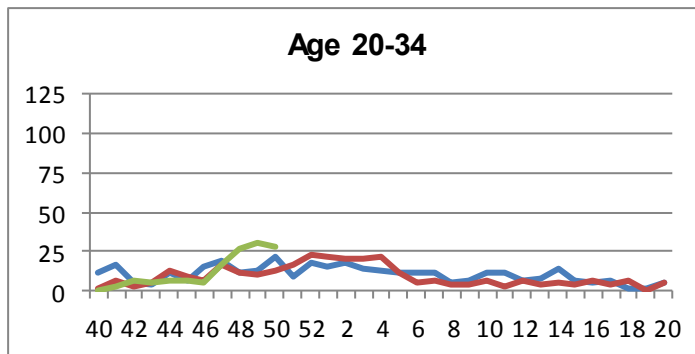
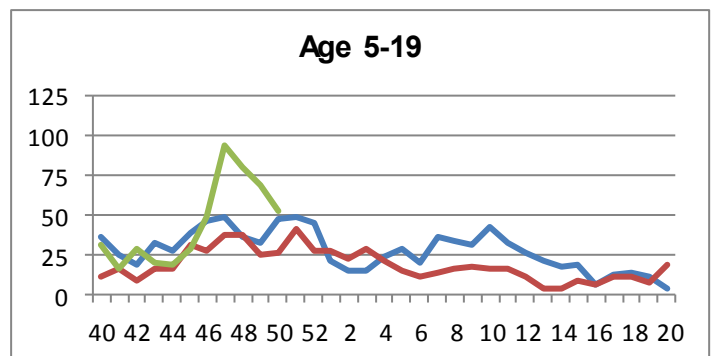
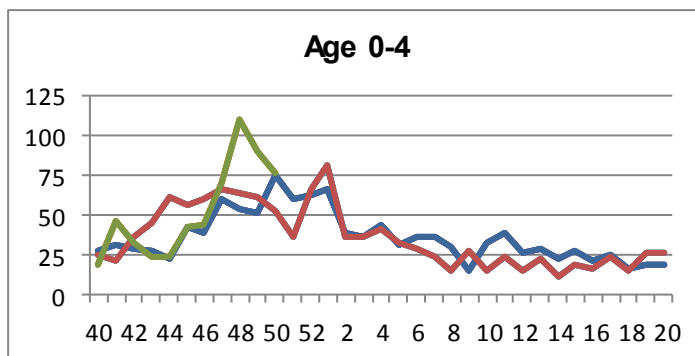
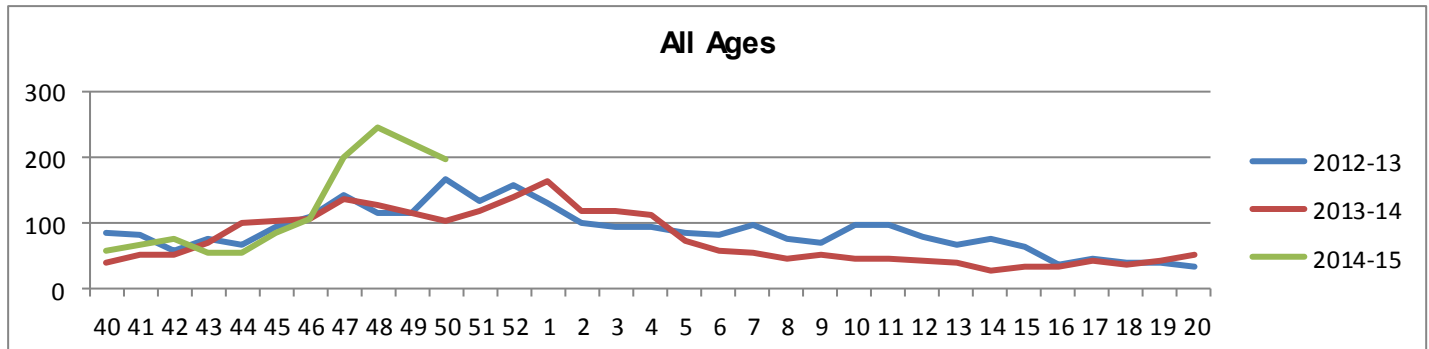


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Influenza-Like Illness (ILI) Emergency Department visits from two (2) Escambia hospitals.
